

Are **YOU** interested in reforesting marginal agricultural or sloped lands, creating or improving wildlife habitat, establishing windbreaks or planting along stream banks?

For Small Plantings:

If you will be planting **100-500 trees**, the **Bruce Resource Stewardship Network** provides a **40 cent/seedling subsidy**. Order early, as the Network will subsidize only the first 6,250 seedlings purchased.

YOU can start small, and make it an annual event.

For Larger Plantings:

If you decide to **plant 500 trees or more**, contact the **Saugeen Conservation** (519-367-3040) or the **Grey Sauble Conservation** (519-376-3076). The Trees for Tomorrow program will provide a minimum **rebate of 10 cents per tree** to landowners who order a minimum of **500 trees** or more.

Order forms can be obtained from the Grey Bruce Forestry Service.

Guidelines for Seedling Selection

First consider the soil type. Is it sandy, loam, or clay, or a mixture? Second consider location and moisture conditions. If wet, plant species such as: white cedar, tamarack, and silver maple. If dry plant species such as: white pine, white spruce, and sugar maple.

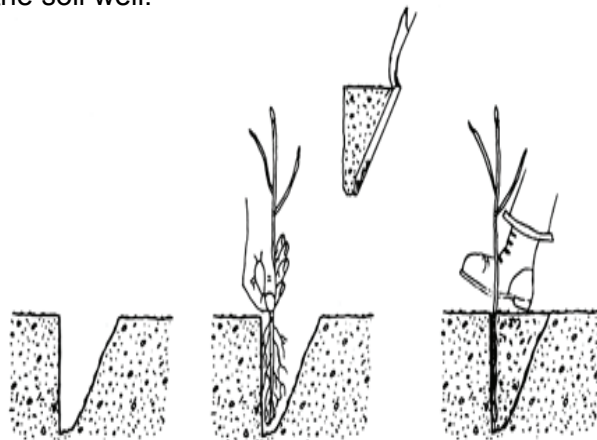

Remember the most expensive planting is a failed planting! So observe your survival rate. Next year make adjustments so that survival rate increases.

How to Plant

Keep the roots moist but not wet. Space seedlings 8-10'. Plant the root collar at ground level and keep all the roots are buried. Pack the soil well.
