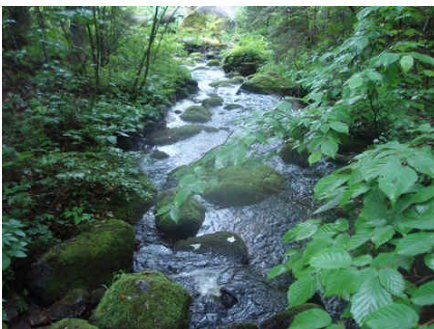


Join us for the one-day hands-on session and learn about native plants of eastern Ontario. Our three presenters will address:
